# **PROJECT STRATEGY**

## Project Strategy:

Briefly explain the steps that will be used to complete the project from beginning to end.

- Students will first read a book independently over the course of three weeks.
- Teacher instruction on question types
- Teacher instruction on iPad usage
- Prewrite condensed story
